UKRAINE CRISIS





The FCA Ukraine Crisis Relief Fund has been created to provide vital emergency relief for FCA teammates and their families who are still in Ukraine and those who have been displaced to other countries. The Fund's purpose is to help with unforeseeable expenses that are beyond our teammates' control and are a result of this crisis.

The FCA ministry in Ukraine was founded in 2009 and has grown to 22 Ukrainian staff in addition to 6 staff in the FCA Divisional Office who serve both Europe and Eurasia. When the war on Ukraine began on February 24, 2022, 14 FCA Ukraine staff and 16 family members were in the U.S. at FCA's all-staff conference, and 14 staff were still in Ukraine.

As each Ukrainian staff has responded to the challenging circumstances of this crisis, we adjusted our approach and established three ministry teams: Team Ukraine, Team Europe and Team Support in Kansas City. Team Ukraine has 9 staff focused on serving coaches and athletes in Ukraine. Team Europe has 7 staff focused on serving Ukrainian coaches and athletes displaced across Europe. Team Support in Kansas City has 6 staff focused on mobilizing resources and communication.

As we continue to pray for this developing situation, we understand that the families and individuals impacted will need assistance with housing and basic needs. Your funding support will help us meet their current, immediate needs in the following ways:

TEAM UKRAINE:

- Staff Living Expenses: \$18,000
 - We will work with each family to financially support the increased living expenses required to live in their new situations. The total amount of additional support for 9 families is \$18,000 for next 6 months at \$3,000 per month.
- Operational Ministry: \$287,800

As many Ukrainian coaches and athletes are now displaced in various European countries, there are new ministry opportunities to serve them. We are hiring new Ukrainian staff to help organize multiple events to encourage coaches and athletes to experience the hope of Jesus. We are also establishing a rehab sport center where coaches and athletes can be restored physically, emotionally and spiritually. FCA Events \$33,000; Rehab Sports Center \$230,800; New Staff \$24,000.

• Support Ukraine Coaches & Athletes: \$90,000

Many coaches and volunteers are suffering because of the war and remain in Ukraine in their cities trying to survive. We want to give \$15,000 monthly to support 100 coaches and volunteers for 6 months.

TEAM EUROPE:

- Housing 5 Homes: \$90,000
 - We need to rent 5 homes for staff to be able to host coaches and athletes who are evacuating from Ukraine. The plan is to have 2 in Germany, 2 in Poland and 1 in Netherlands. We want to rent these homes for 6 months (\$3,000/month per home). The total amount needed for 5 rental homes is \$90,000.
- Staff Living Expenses: \$18,000

We will work with each family to financially support the increased living expenses required to live in their new locations. The total amount of additional support for 7 families is \$18,000 for next 6 months at \$3,000 per month.

Support Ukraine Coaches & Athletes: \$42,000
 Many coaches and volunteers evacuated to neighboring countries. We want to give \$7,000 monthly to support 50 coaches and volunteers for 6 months.



TEAM SUPPORT IN KANSAS CITY:

- Staff Living Expenses: \$24,000
 - We will work with each family to help adjust their income to financially support the increased living expenses required to live in the U.S. In addition, FCA has secured medical insurance to care for these families. The total amount needed is \$4,000 per month to support the families in Kansas City. The total need for 6 months is \$24,000.
- Operational Support: \$60,000
 - We need to provide ongoing leadership, encouragement and evaluation for ongoing needs and resources. These funds will cover travel and training expenses. Total is: \$60,000.
- Sports Equipment Cost in KC: \$72,000
 Equipment shipment with Convoy of Hope is essential to bring to coaches necessary sport equipment to restart their programs or start new clubs around Ukraine. These funds will be used to ship 3 containers of sport equipment to Poland and deliver to Ukraine. Total is: \$72,000.

Total cost of all projects for 6 months of support is \$701,800.

Together we will support Ukrainians' immediate, practical and spiritual needs throughout this crisis.
