

### BACKGROUND

Sport transcends age, race, gender, economics, and even nationality. As a result, FCA works with local sport ministry leaders and existing ministries in the South Pacific International Region. The impact is growing in the South Pacific through teams and sports leaders.

Camp Ministry and Coaches Ministry are key to expand ministry in communities in the South Pacific. We are intentional in training sports leaders to establish ministry in their countries. Coaches Ministry is growing through our 3Dimensional Coaching program leading to the formation of Coaches Huddles.

## CHALLENGE

- Among the nations of the South Pacific International Region, there is a leadership void for many churches. There is a need for committed ministry leaders to teach faithfully the Word of God.
- The younger generations in many nations have little opportunity for employment and education. Many of these nations have 40% population under the age of 25.
- The rise of immigration confronts churches, especially in New Zealand and Australia. As many immigrant communities are growing, the need for discipleship efforts among these peoples are great.
